Eliminating education barriers in Longmont

For many parents, finding reliable childcare is a major challenge to their ability to complete their English education. In January, Intercambio's dream of offering on-site childcare came true.

The Longmont office now has 12 spaces available for childcare! The first term was a huge success with nine children, and the second term is off to a great start with 12 children enrolled.

Intercambio is taking the opportunity to create a positive first experience of "school" for these young people.

Our childcare providers are charged with planning fun, educational and structured activities for children ranging in ages from infant to 4 years old. During one recent class, kids made butterflies out of recycled paper!



Parents have the opportunity to learn while their children are cared for in Longmont.

One student, Brenda, has noticed changes in her daughter since coming to childcare. "She's learning a lot and speaking English at home!" she said.

We believe that giving kids the opportunity to be present while their parents learn provides a foundation for successful educational endeavors.

Intercambio receives national acknowledgment

The Commission on Adult Basic Education (COABE) is a national organization that inspires educators so that adults succeed and thrive. With 13,000 members nationwide, they provide a variety of services to provide leadership, communication, professional development, and advocacy for adult education.

This year, Intercambio's Executive Director Lee Shainis was nominated by community members for COABE's *Outstanding Administrator of the Year* award, and **was selected as the national Runner Up!**

COABE recognized Lee and Intercambio for outstanding work in fostering meaningful relationships between immigrants and receiving communities, and understanding the specific challenges facing immigrant learners to build a deep sense of community among all involved.

Learning English to connect

Nancy Rivas has been attending Intercambio classes for nine years, and started in the first level.

Nancy fondly remembers her Level 1 class where she went to her neighbor's house, 1-year-old daughter in tow to learn with her teacher Mary Jane. Showing incredible perseverance, Nancy just finished Level 7.

Nancy recounts her breakthrough moment. She was standing at the bus stop, and someone came to ask her if she was waiting for the bus, and what time it would leave. "I understood, and I could speak," recalls Nancy with a smile. "I felt like, 'wow, I can hear!"

"You feel more a part of the country and culture when you understand the people," she explains.

Now, she uses her abilities often. "My girls are so proud of me because I don't need [a] translator when I go to [their school] conference."

She also uses her language skills to give back, often translating for her extended family, and making announcements on the bus for other passengers.

Nancy has graduated from Intercambio's six level curriculum. She is using her final term to focus on improving her reading and writing skills, as well as building vocabulary.

In the future, she hopes to earn her GED, which motivates her to continue classes to improve her English. "It's a challenge," she explains.

Nancy is proud of how her hard work to learn English has helped her accomplish her goals, and looks forward to the future!
