

Students and Teachers Cooking Together 2017

KEEP IT SIMPLE!

What: The teacher and student* prepare a dish that is common in the student's home culture, and then bring it to an authentic world cuisine party at the Boulder Intercambio office.

When: After the student and teacher agree to do it, they sign up online at the link below. The teacher and student cook together on Saturday, **November 11**th, with the food ready at **5:30 pm** to take to the party OR food is prepared during the week during class time and heated and brought to the party.

Teachers:

1. Set aside a date for a cooking lesson (in English) led by the student. (It could be the same day of your class or at a different time.)

Students:

- 1. Select a recipe to make (that feeds 8+)
- 2. Purchase the ingredients, have them on hand for the cooking lesson
- 3. Using your English vocabulary, prepare the dish together

Purpose:

- 1. Students are sharing their culture and heritage with the teacher, a role reversal
- 2. Teacher bonds with student in a new way
- 3. Practice of writing food and instructions
- 4. Gather at a party to meet other students and teachers, and get them more connected with the greater Intercambio community

Bring your dish and come to the Boulder Intercambio Office (4735 Walnut St., Suite B) at **5:30PM on Saturday, November 11**th for food and fun!
